



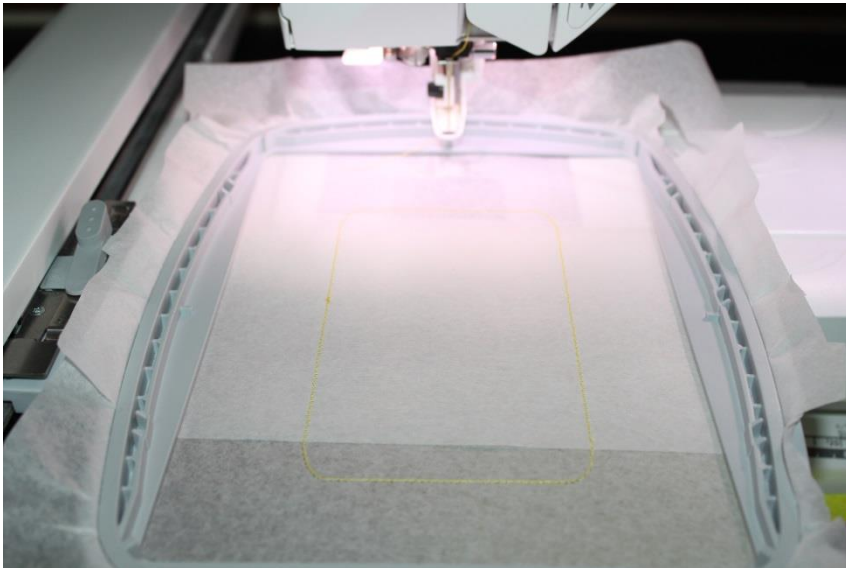
Cindy Phone Case & Device Case

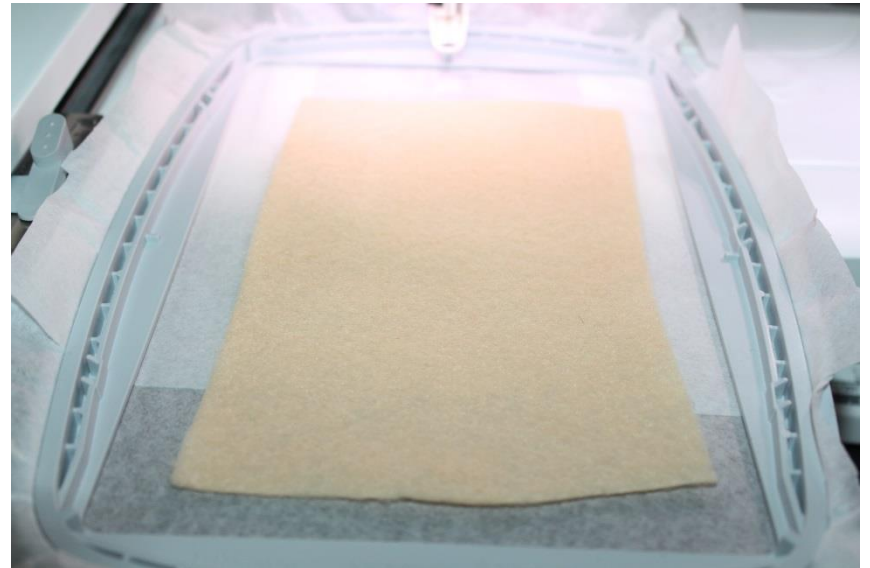

Hoop your stabilizer (I use tear away) and stitch the placement line.



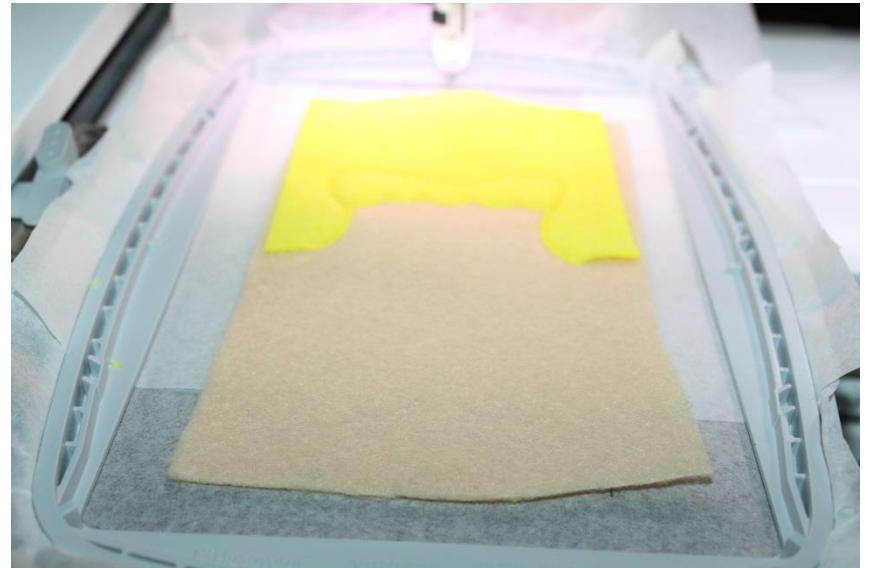
Lay your felt down for the skin tone, this will be your main piece of felt.



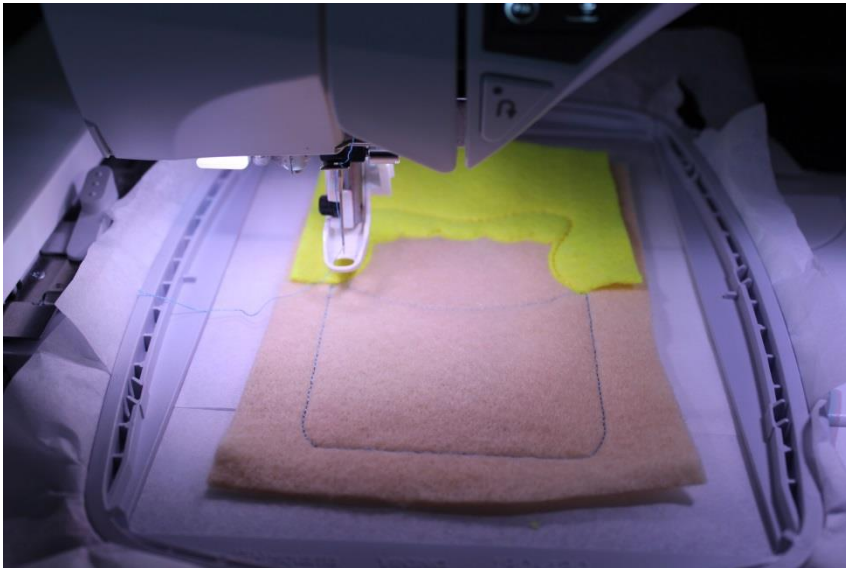
Run the placement line, then lay felt over the line for the hair.



Run the tack down stitch and only trim around the stitched area. When finished, it will look like the picture below.



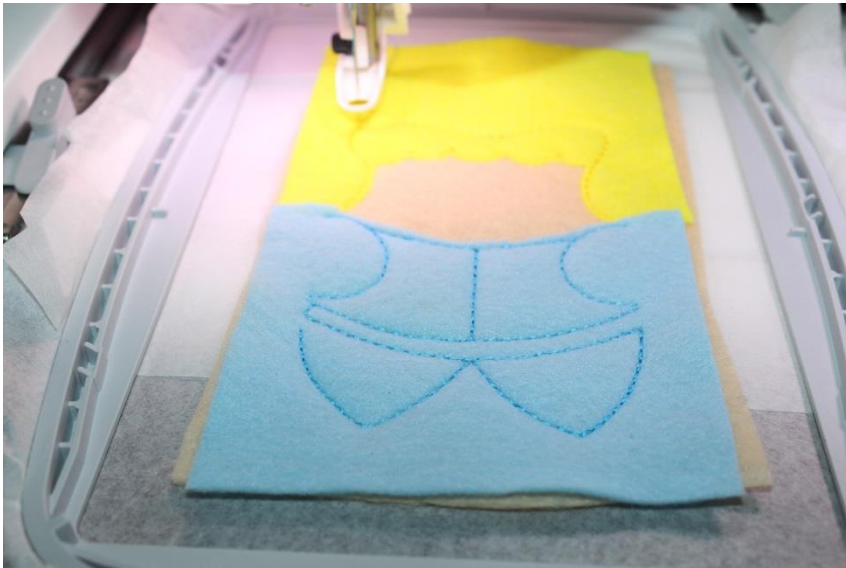
Run the placement line for the dress.



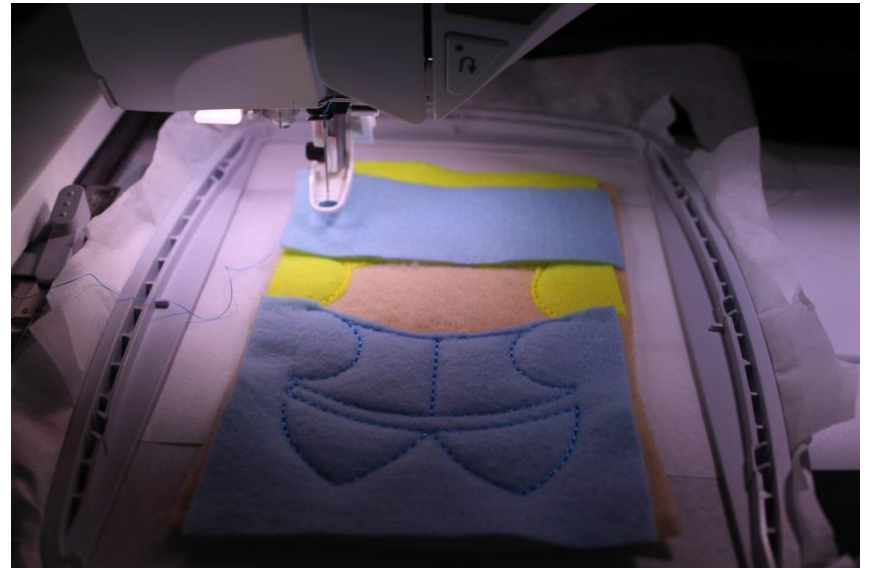
Lay your felt over the placement line.



Stitch the dress details. Only trim around the dress neck area.



Stitch the placement line for the headband. Lay your felt over the line. Run the stitches for the headband.



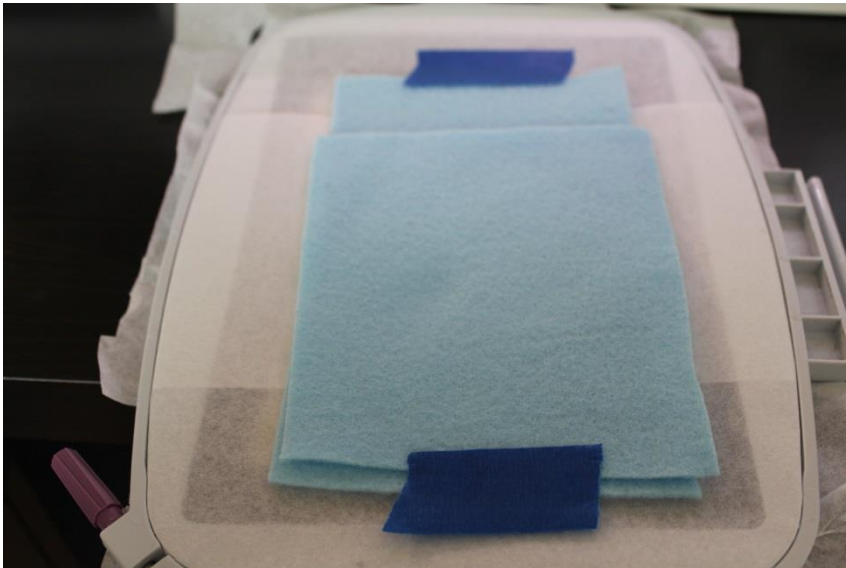
Trim around the headband.



Stitch the face details.



Put a full piece of felt the size of your placement line (this varies depending on the size of the device you're making the cover for) over placement line and another piece ½ inch below the placement line.



Put the hoop back onto your machine and finish up the final steps.



This is what the front will look like when complete.



This is what the back will look like when complete. Trim ¼ inch from the edges and you're done!
