



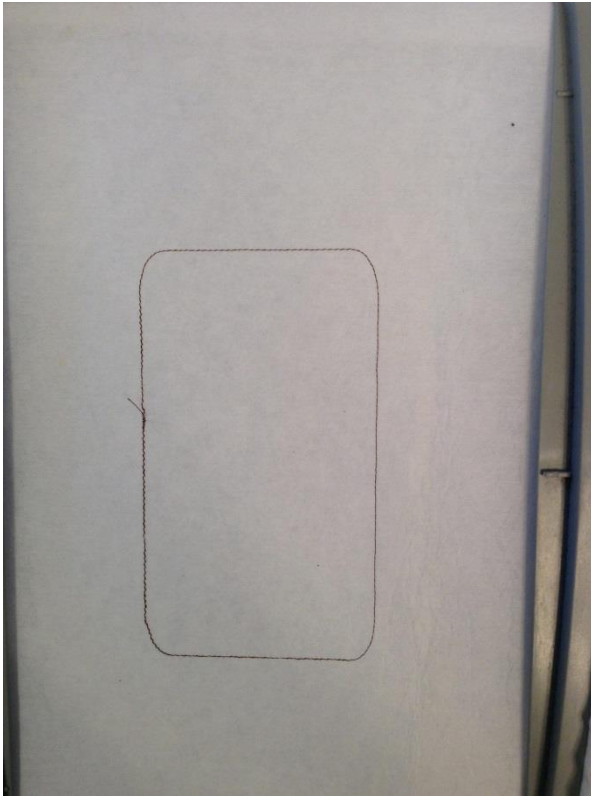

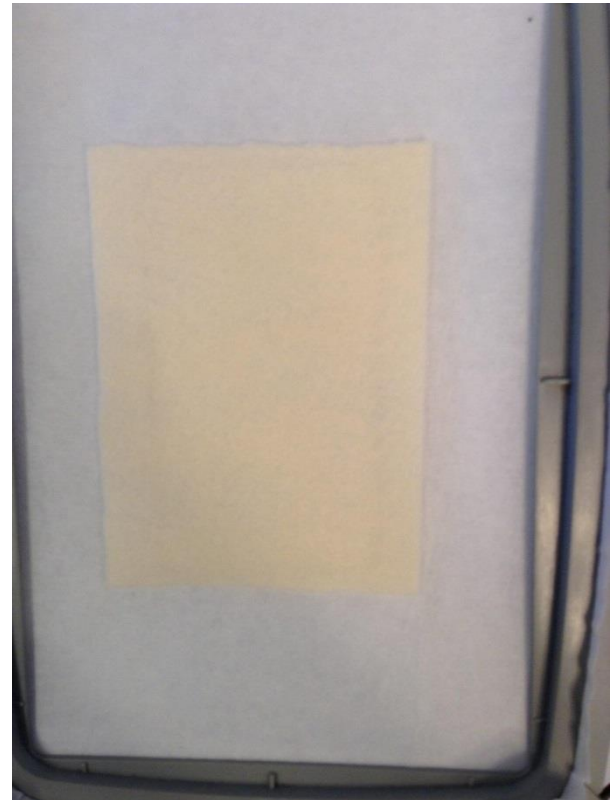

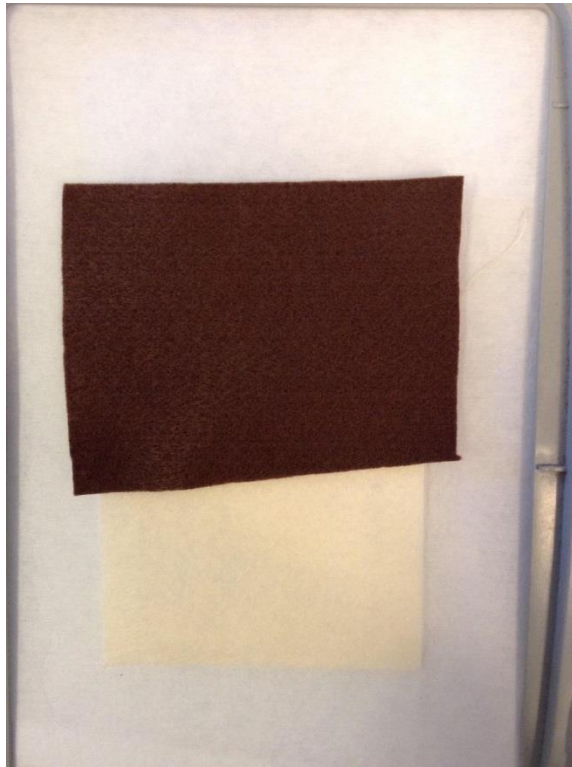
**Hoop your stabilizer (I use tear away)  
and stitch the placement line.**



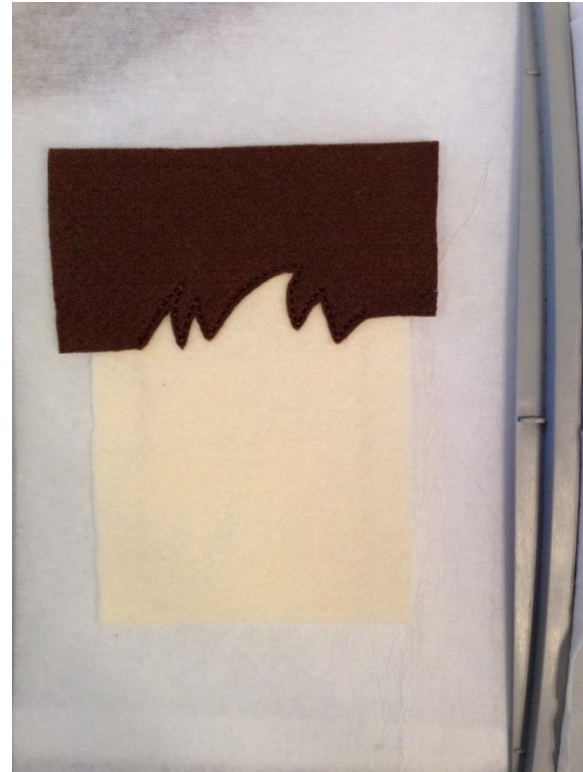
**Lay your felt down for the skin tone, this  
will be your main piece of felt.**



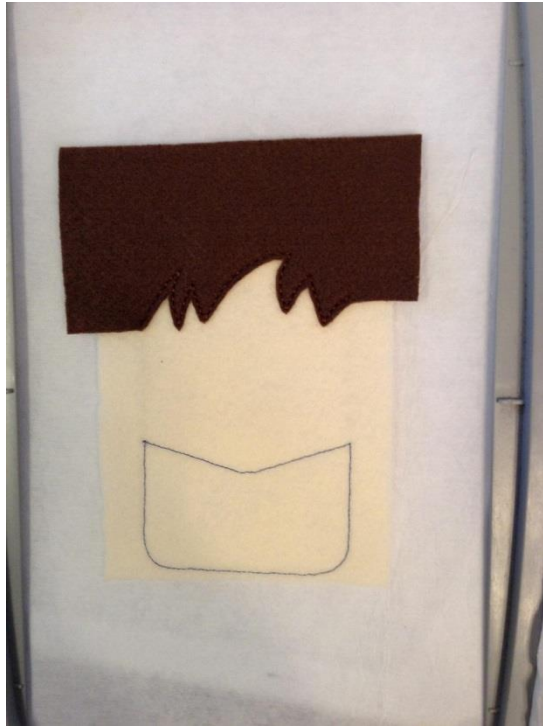
**Run the placement line, then lay felt over the line for the hair.**



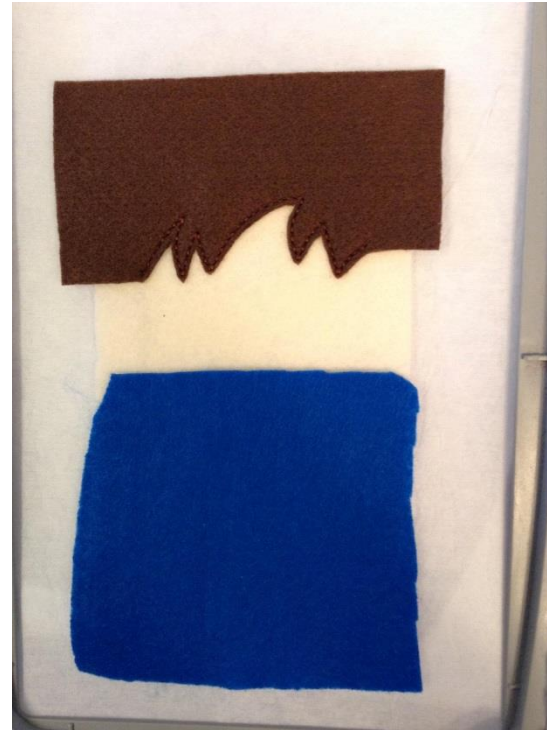
**Run the tack down stitch and only trim around the stitched area. When finished, it will look like the picture below.**



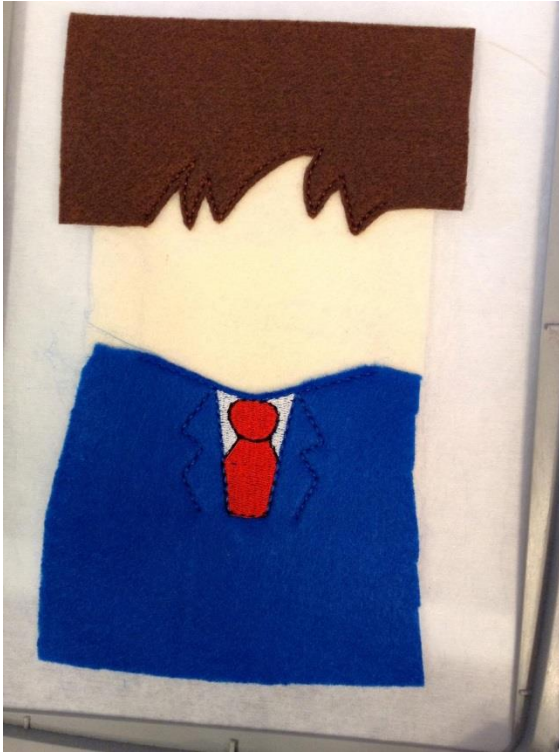
**Run the placement line for the shirt.**



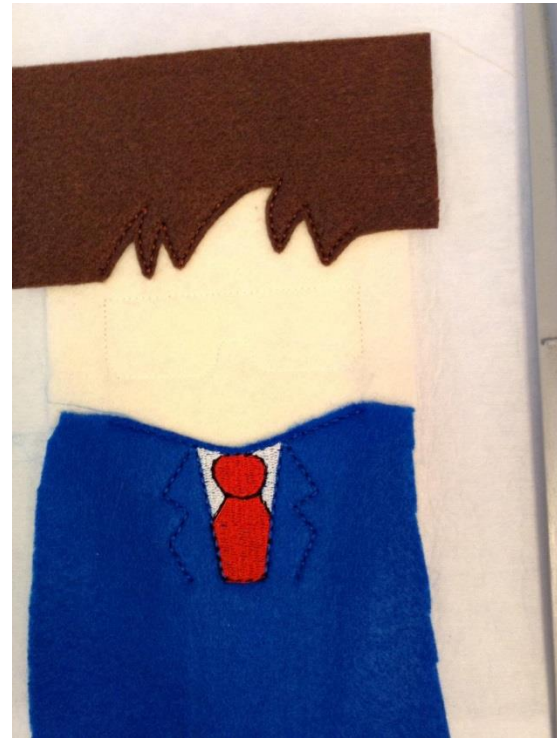
**Lay your felt over the placement line.**



**Stitch the shirt details. Only trim around the dress neck area.**

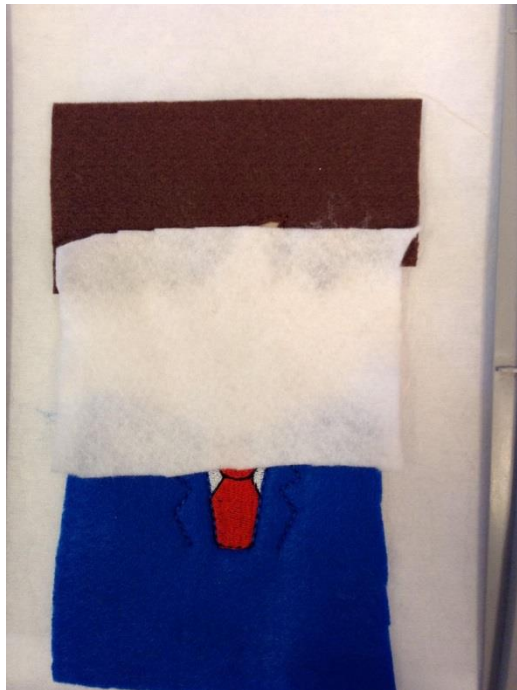


**Stitch the placement line for the glasses.**





**Lay your felt over the placement line.**



**Stitch the glasses.**



**Trim around the glasses. Then stitch the placement line for the 2 square lenses.**



**Lay your felt over the placement line for the left lense only.**



**Stitch the left lense.**



**Trim around the left square lense.**





**Lay your felt over the placement line for the right lense.**



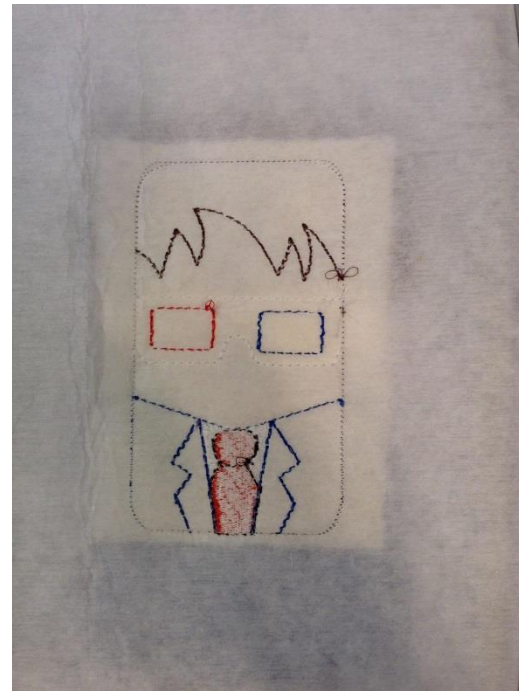
**Stitch the right lense.**



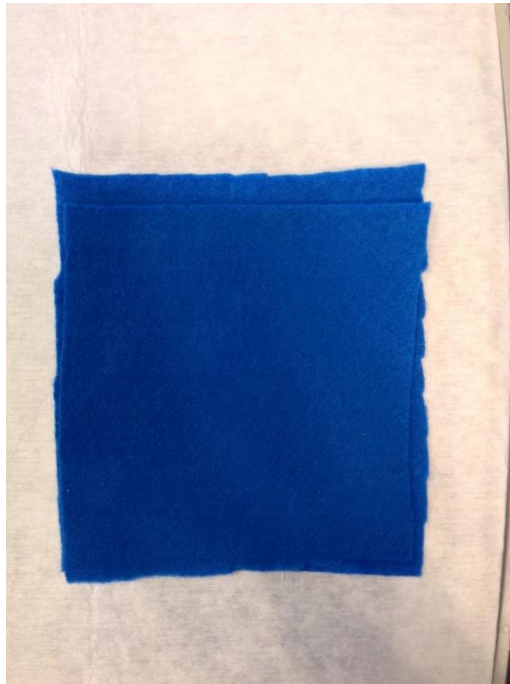
**Trim around the right square lense.**



**Remove your hoop from your machine.  
(Do not unhoop your project.) This is  
what the back will look like.**



**Put a full piece of felt the size of your placement line (this varies depending on the size of the device you're making the cover for) over placement line and another piece ½ inch below the placement line.**



**Put the hoop back onto your machine and finish up the final steps. This is what the front will look like when complete.**



**Unhoop your project. Trim  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch from the edges and you're done!**
