



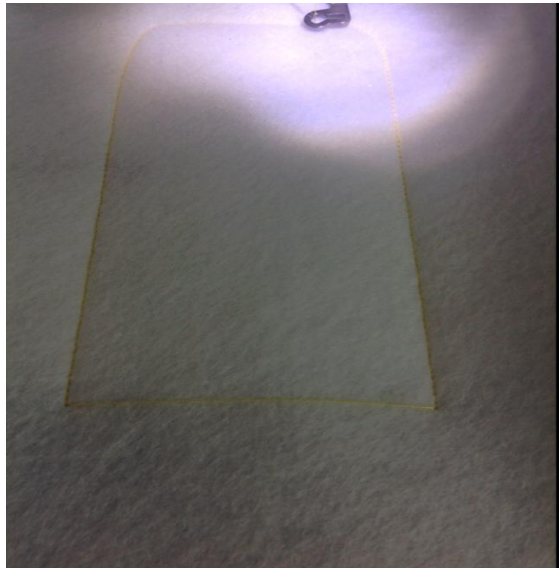

**\*When you send your design to your machine two files will be there. Step 1 (boxed in red) which takes place at the first position or top of the hoop, and Step 2 (boxed in green) which takes place at the second position or bottom of the hoop.\***

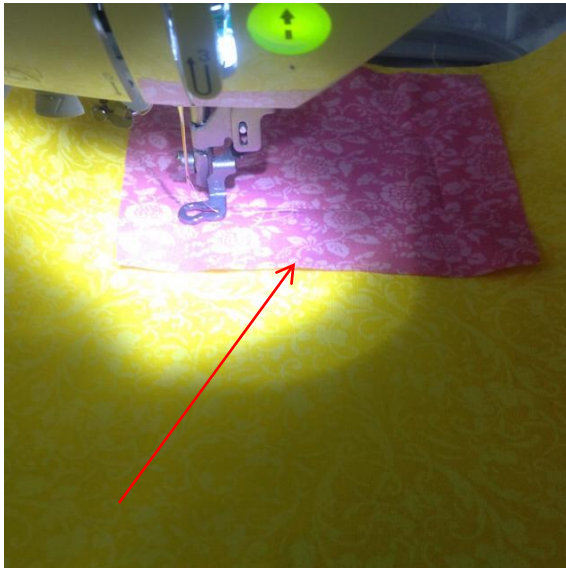
**Hoop your stabilizer and run Step 1 the placement line. Place your pencil fabric down covering the whole hoop.**



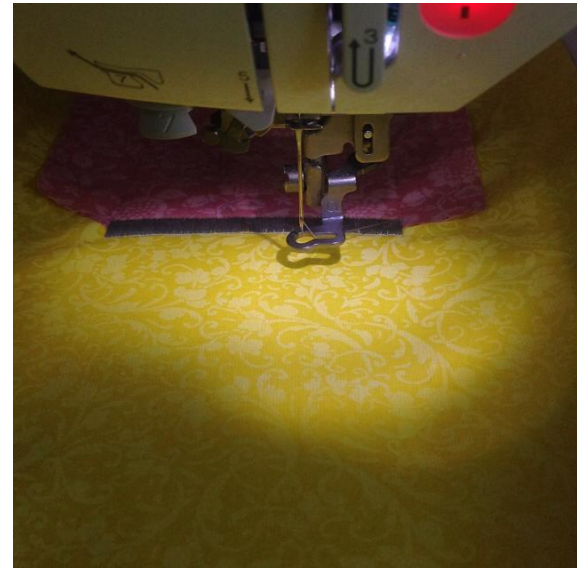
**Run step 2 the placement line for the eraser fabric. Place a piece of fabric for your eraser then run Step 3.**



**Trim the fabric close to the stitch  
line the arrow is pointing to.**



**Run step 4**



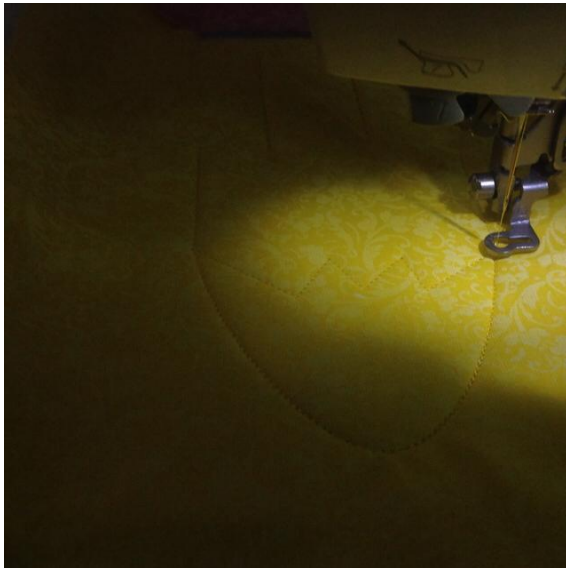
**Run step 5, the center lines on  
the pencil.**



**SKIP STEP 6, you will go back to this step  
at the end. Change your hoop position  
to the SECOND or bottom position now.**

**Stitch out placement lines  
step 1 and step 2.**

*\*Chart on 2<sup>nd</sup> page lists them as steps 7 & 8\**



**Place your fabric over the placement  
line for the tip of the pencil and stitch  
out step 3.**

*\*Chart lists this as step 9\**





**Trim around the zig zag part of  
the pencil tip and run step 4.**

*\*chart lists this as step 10\**



**Stitch step 5 the center lines of the  
pencil.**

*\*chart lists this as step 11\**



**Stitch step 6 the pencil point.**

***\*Chart lists this as step 12.\****



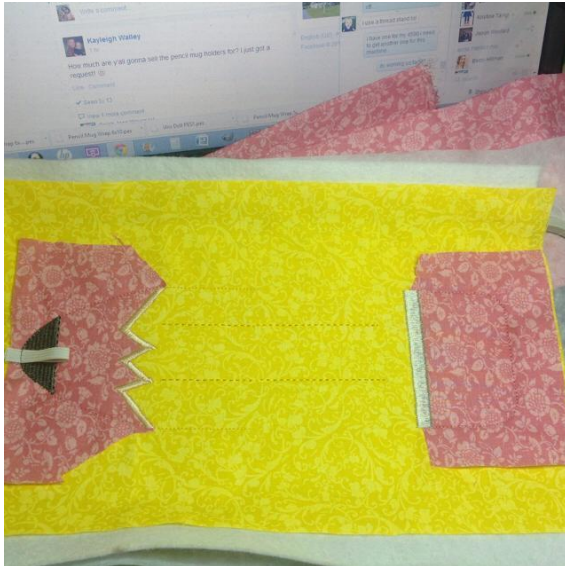
**Stitch out step 7 the placement line for elastic and place a piece of elastic folded in half like shown and tape in place. Stitch step 8 to secure it in place.**

***\*Chart lists this as steps 13 & 14\****





**This is what you should have at this point. DO NOT UN HOOP.**



**Place fabric right side facing down making sure to cover your whole design and stitch out step 15.**



**Skip to the end of your design using the button that looks like a spool with a + sign. It may be a button on your machine or in the adjust menu. Run the last step, step 6.**

**Go back to Step 1 of the design file (where we started with the bottom end of the pencil) and change the hoop back to FIRST position.**



**Trim around design keep a ½” or so of fabric near the turning hole. Iron and top stitch or ladder stitch the opening closed. Sew on a Button in the middle of the eraser and your done!**
