





ITH Frog Blanket Buddy



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Hours of work go into designing and testing each design.

Please respect the creativity & time it takes to complete each design.

Hoop your stabilizer and attach to your machine. It is recommended you use a 90/14 needle.





Run the placement stitches for the feet.

Place a piece of corresponding fabric RIGHT SIDES together and stitch out the feet. Remove from the machine and cut feet out leaving a seam allowance, and turn RIGHT SIDE out.





Hoop another piece of stabilizer, place blanket piece of fabric RIGHT SIDE up and run placement stitch.





Send block for feet and then tape or just place on top.

Run tack down/placement stitches for the feet. It is recommended that you slow down the needle speed. (Note: You can run the needle by hand using the wheel on the right if needed.)






Place blanket fabric RIGHT SIDES together and stitch in place. Remove hoop and cut out. Leave a seam allowance.






Hoop another piece of stabilizer and place frog head fabric RIGHT SIDE up. Run placement stitches.







Place frog's face fabric RIGHT SIDES together.





Stitch together. (Note the opening at the base of the frog's head.)

Stuff the blanket body RIGHT SIDE out through the base of the frog's head. Leave a seam allowance.

(Note: Make sure raw edge of blanket is going to be attached at the base of the head.)





Stitch the frog's head closed.

(Note: There will be a small opening allowed for turning later.)





Remove the hoop and cut the frog's head out. Leave a seam allowance.

(Note: Leave a little extra allowance at opening.)

Turn the frog RIGHT SIDE out by pulling through the opening at the side of the head. Stuff the frog's head to the desired firmness and slip stitch the opening closed. Enjoy!
