



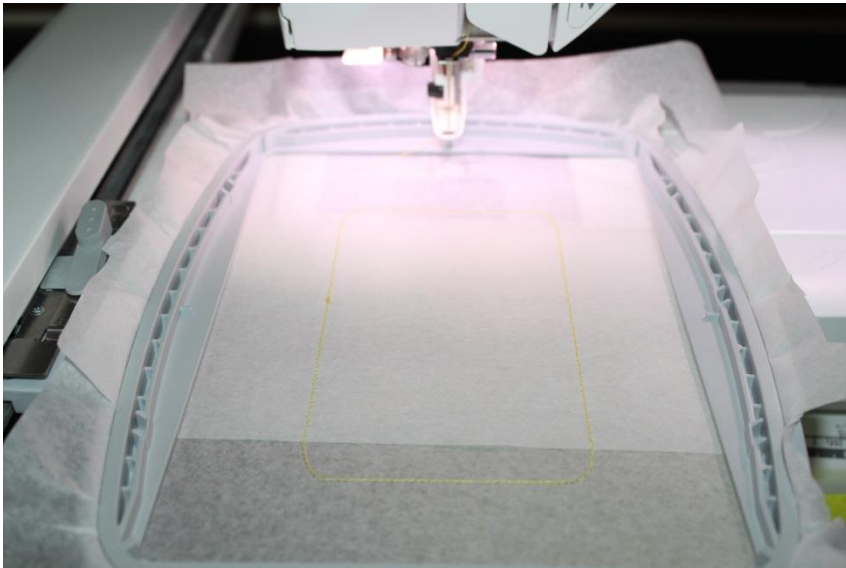

# Lady Bug Legs & Head

**Hoop stabilizer (I use cut-away)  
Stitch placement line on  
stabilizer run placement line on  
stabilizer**

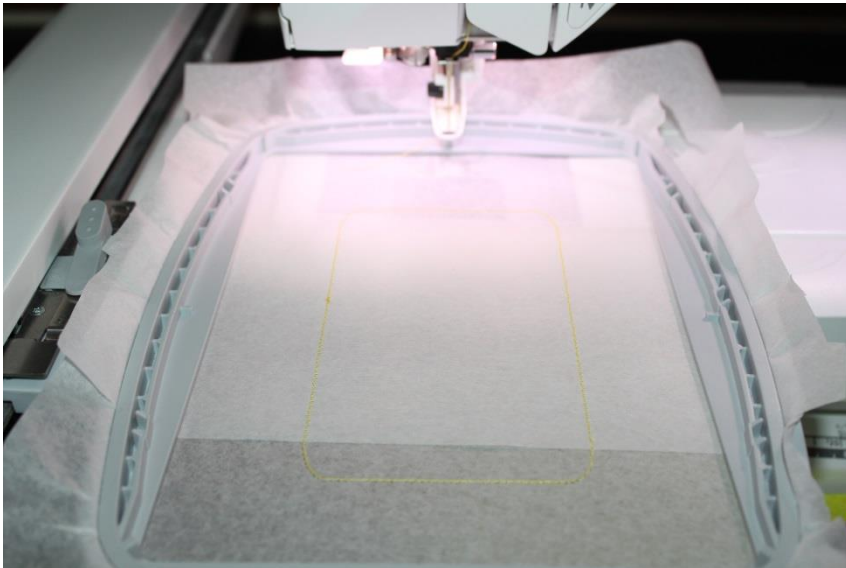
**Lay both leg and head fabric right  
sides together and stitch last step.**



# Lady Bug Body

Run placement for applique pieces then lay fabric over tack down and trim Repeat for each step.

**Run placement for applique pieces then lay fabric over tack down and trim Repeat for each step. Tack down and only trim around the stitched area it will look like picture.**



**Repeat for each applique piece  
4x4 spots are stitched not applique**



**Run Placement Lines for legs and  
Head**





**Lay head over placement line like pictured  
and tack down – Repeat for each leg**



**When finished will look like this There  
are now 6 legs instead of just 4 ;)**



**Lay belly fabric face down on top  
of your ladybug**



**Stitch final outline**



**Trim  $\frac{1}{4}$  inc around except  
opening leave enough to tuck in  
and  
pictu**



**Turn Right side up stuff and  
close!**
