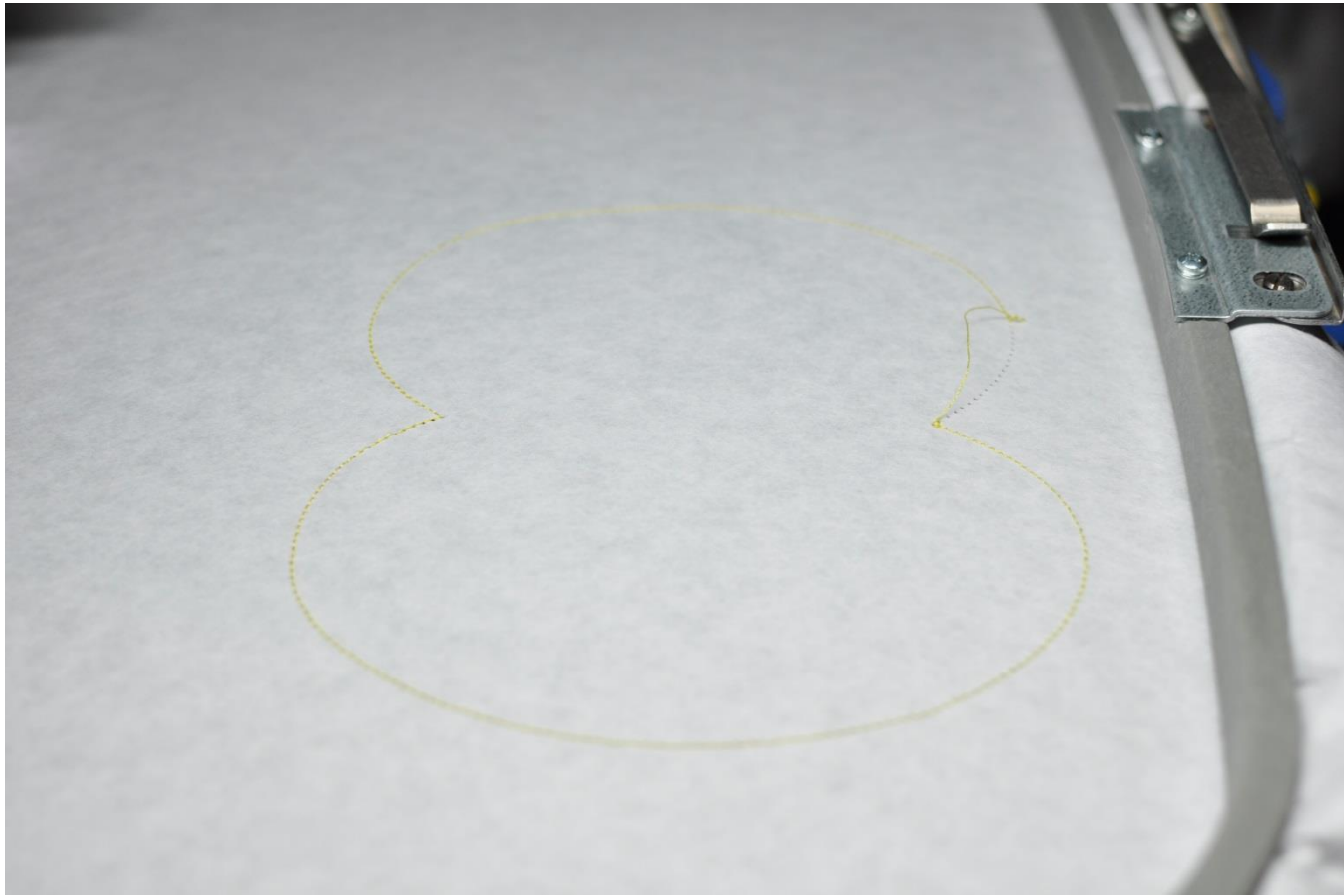
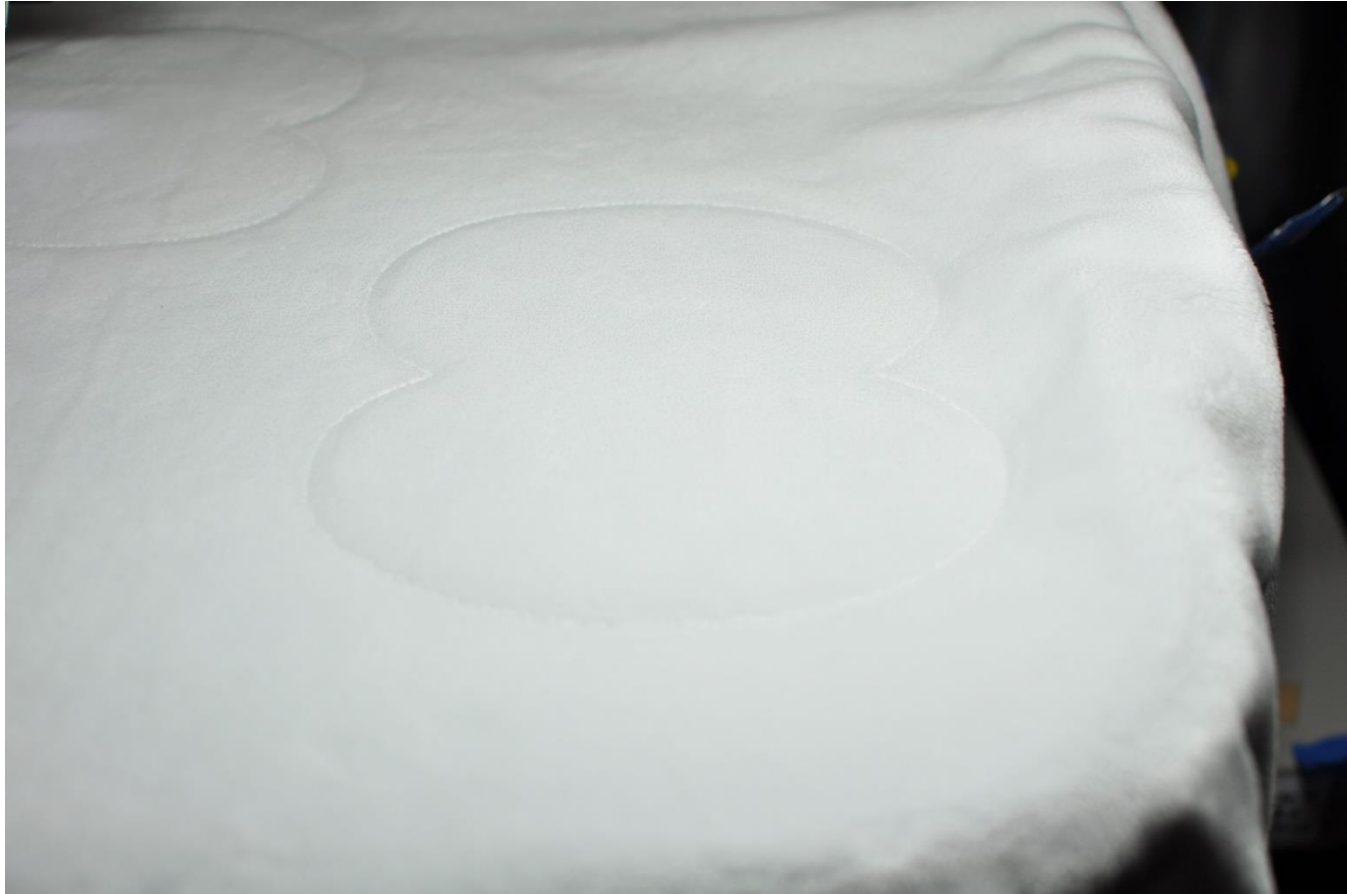


Panda Stuffie Instruction





Hoop stabilizer and stitch step 1 (placement stitch) on to stabilizer.



Put fabric about size of hoop right side up over placement stitch and stitch step 3 (tack down line for body).



Stitch step 3 (placement line for eyes, ears, arms and legs).



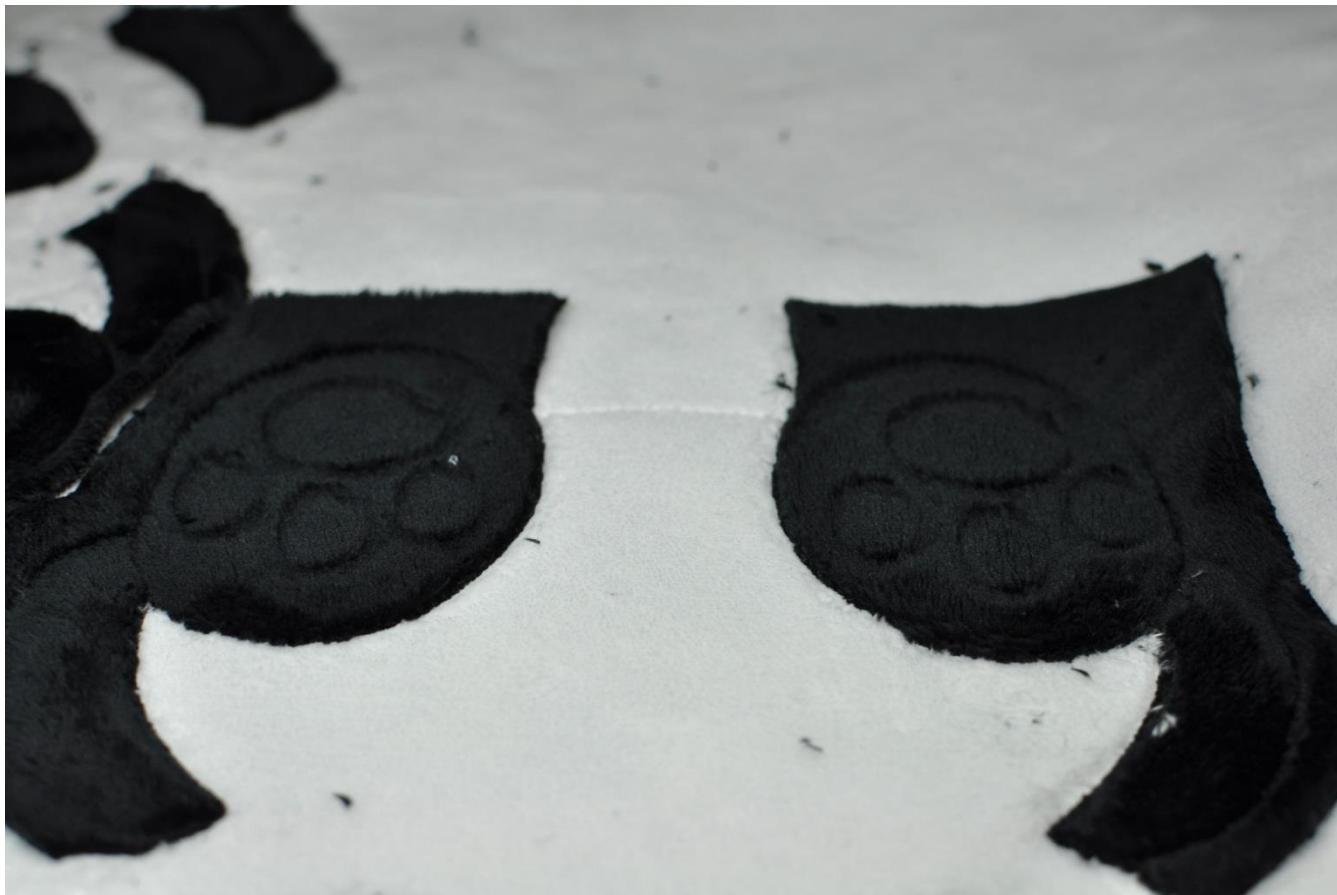
Put another piece fabric about size of hoop over placement stitch and stitch step 4 (tack down line for eyes, ears, arms and legs).



Trim close around eyes and inner edges of ears, arms and legs as shown and leave seam allowance for outer edges. Stitch step 5 (finishing stitch for applique and nose/mouth).



Stitch step 6 (eyes). Use WSS if fabric has pile.



Stitch step 7 (placement line for paws).



Put fabric over placement stitch and stitch step 8 (tack down for paws). Trim around tack down lines. Stitch step 9.



Put back fabric about size of hoop right side down over and stitch step 10. Remove from hoop. Remove as much stabilizer as possible. Trim and leave about .25 inch seam allowance. Turn and stuff. Close opening with ladder stitch. Enjoy!
